Seeking Strategic Financial Leader for SF Bay Area Parks Nonprofit

The Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy is hiring a Chief Financial Officer (CFO). We are looking for a hands-on executive leader to guide the Parks Conservancy's financial growth and diversity, investments, and fiscal health and support our Finance and Accounting teams. They will be a collaborator and advisor, bridge builder, developing and implementing financial strategies, monitoring finances and analyzing the organization's financial status.

The CFO will lead the fiscal matters of the Parks Conservancy in alignment with the strategic plan, mission, and values as well as in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. The CFO will lead our Finance and Accounting branch of the organization. They will work in close collaboration with the CEO and other Executives to ensure systems and processes are in place to support shared decision-making informed by strategies and plans that are specific to fundraising and membership acquisition, workforce management, lines of business to pursue, and operational infrastructure modernization.

We are a nonprofit business that conducts fundraising and membership activities (contributed revenue streams), as well as operating two key lines of business (earned revenue streams). The annual earned revenue ranges from \$40-\$50m, with variation in the contributed revenue. The Parks Conservancy is considering opportunities to expand our lines of revenue and the CFO will be actively engaged in the process to identify, evaluate, and decide on opportunities to pursue.

ABOUT THE GOLDEN GATE PARKS CONSERVANCY

At the Bay Area's doorstep are some of the most beautiful and diverse national park sites anywhere. The Golden Gate National Parks Conservancy (Parks Conservancy) has led the transformation and restoration of one of California's national parks, the Golden Gate National Recreation Area - encompassing over 80,000 acres north and south of the Golden Gate Bridge. As the nonprofit partner to the National Park Service, we have supported building of new national park sites and visitor centers, rehabilitated historic buildings, restored critical habitat areas, created magnificent park trails and overlooks and enhanced visitor experience through partnerships with artists, educators and other community service organizations throughout the Bay Area.

The parklands include iconic places like Alcatraz Island, Muir Woods National Monument, Fort Point National Historic Site, Ocean Beach, the Presidio, and Crissy Field, each representing the idea that national parks are for everyone. Our 300+ employees are dedicated to connecting people to these incredible resources by enhancing the public's awareness and providing opportunities for enjoyment and stewardship of these incredible places. Our organization's future is focused on centering and engaging community voices in the co-design of park programs and initiatives that spark

engagement around important contemporary issues such as climate change, racial and social justice and barriers to equitable park visitation.
